PRINCE EDWARD POINT OBSERVATORY

- from Kingston, travel west on Hwy 33 to the Glenora Ferry

the Glenora Ferry -leaves the Kingston side on the 1/4 and 3/4 hour

-leaves the Picton side on the 1/2 and full hour

-when you leave the ferry, travel ~.8km

-take first left turn on to regional road 7

-travel ~4km (past Lake on the Mountain)

-turn right on regional road 25

-travel ~2.5km

-turn left on county road 8

-travel ~1.8km

-turn right on regional road 13 (watch carefully for this turn, it's on a curve -- if you miss it you'll go down a hill and be on your way to Waupoos --oops!!)

-travel ~2km

-turn left at T junction (main road)

-stay on regional road 13 -- you'll pass through Black River....keep going....you'll pass a little museum with a

lighthouse at South Bay...keep going....

-once past South Bay the road is known as Long Pt. road and eventually turns to gravel

 -the road curves in many areas, there are branching sideroads, and another T junction -- keep to the left on the main road

-once in the wildlife area (you'll see blue signs to this effect) keep going until you reach a brown cottage on your right (it has a flag pole outside)
